3 NEW BUS LINES IN JERUSALEM

AS OF NOVEMBER 5, 2021 - 1 KISLEV, 5782

Dear Jerusalem Residents,

Currently, the Ministry of Transport, lead by the Minister Merav Michaeli and the General Director Michal Frank, are leading improvements in public transport that would enable you to leave your private car at home and choose public transport instead.

Three new bus lines are about to be launched from the southern neighborhoods to the business districts and high-demand centers in town.

The new lines will be traveling along fast lanes, getting you to your destination quickly and conveniently.

- A line from Talpote East to the Givat Shaul Industrial Zone, which will also enable new city connections to the Jerusalem Theater, Shaare Zedek Medical Center and more.
- A line from Homat Shmuel to the Central Bus Station via Begin Ave., enabling the Homat Shmuel residents quick, convenient access to the city entrance and Government City.
- A line from Homat Shmuel and Gilo to Har Hotzvim via Begin Ave., enabling the Homat Shmuel and Gilo residents quick, convenient access to the business district in Har Hotzvim.

This is yet another step in the overall process of adding 20 new bus lines, which are going to be brought into service gradually, operated by Superbus.

Jerusalem stands at the threshold of a major revamp of its public transport. In the coming years we are going to continue to expand service throughout the city as part of our policy to provide each and every person the possibility to benefit from high-quality, efficient and advanced public transport, thus enabling you to leave your cars at home, save time, money and unnecessary inconvenience.

Dear Passengers,

Superbus is proud to be part of yet another contributor in improving public transport for the greater good of the public in Israel.

We thank the Ministry of Transport and the National Public Transport Authority for having entrusted us with the operation of the public transport in such a unique city as Jerusalem.

This July we launched our work in the city with the execution of the first wave of transport lines, which included a special new tourist line connecting the city to the Western wall.

Now we are excited to proceed with the second wave.

This time we have adjusted the public transport network in Central Jerusalem cluster in order to enhance intracity connectivity, to reinforce the existing lines and to adjust the departure times to answer for the demand of the passengers within and around the cluster.

As part of this wave we have launched three new lines and upgraded two existing lines.

To meet the growing demand for public transport in the urban metropolitan area, Superbus is expected by 2023 to increase frequencies by approximately 40% inside the cluster, to add new lines and to incorporate a fleet powered by alternative, environmentally friendly bus fleet.

For us at Superbus, winning the tender for operating public transport within the Central Jerusalem cluster is a major milestone, a source of immense pride and also a humbling challenge, with the burden of proof now on our shoulders, thanks to our familiarity with the existing challenges, our extensive experience from the other Superbus clusters nationwide, We are determined to work harder than ever to deliver our passengers high-quality, highly end service - the kind we know we can deliver to our customers.

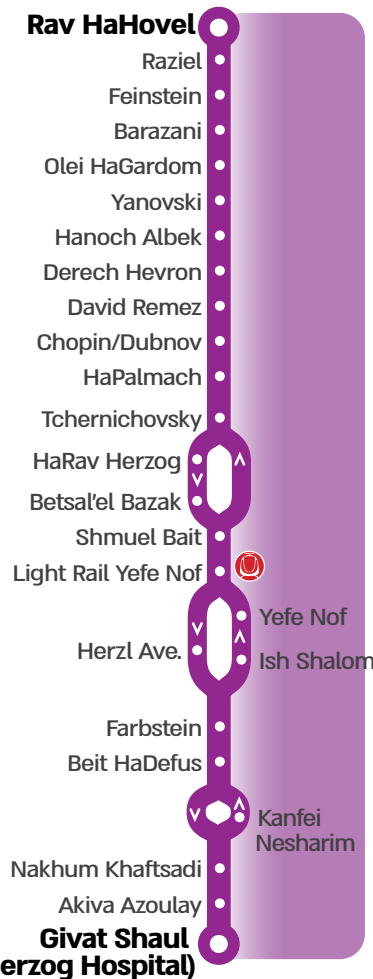


**Talpiot East - Givat Shaul

Quick exit from Oley HaGardom Stret onto Yanovski Street.

Note that the bus collects passengers exiting the neighborhood in the opposite direction of lines 12 and 78.

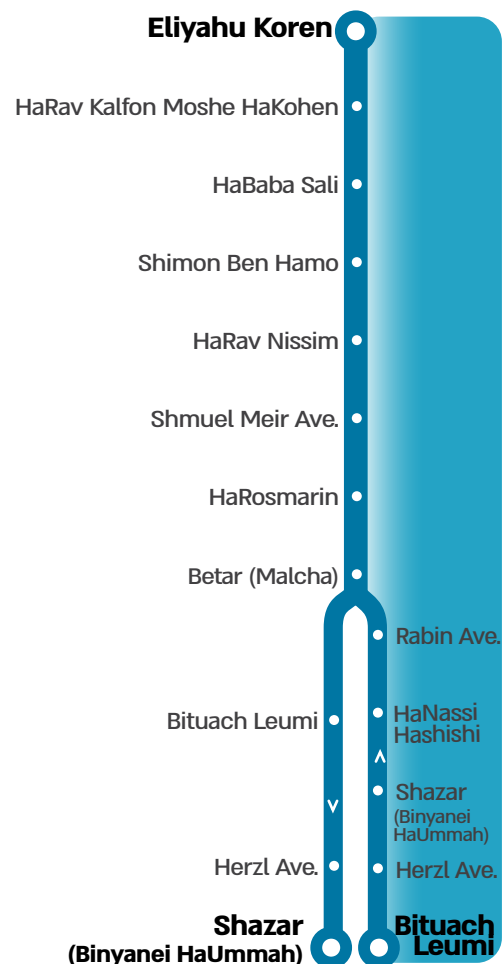
Homat Shmuel - Central Bus Station (Begin Road)

New stations on HaRav Min HaHar and Rachamim Havitah Hakohen will be completed shortly.



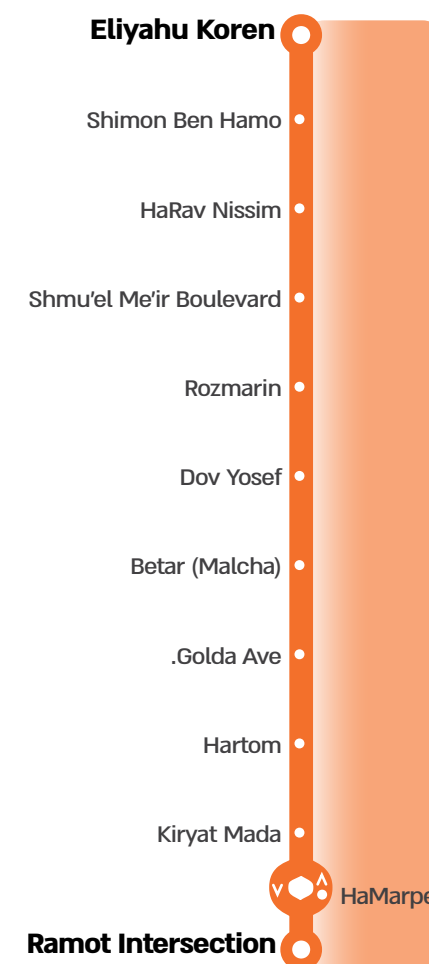

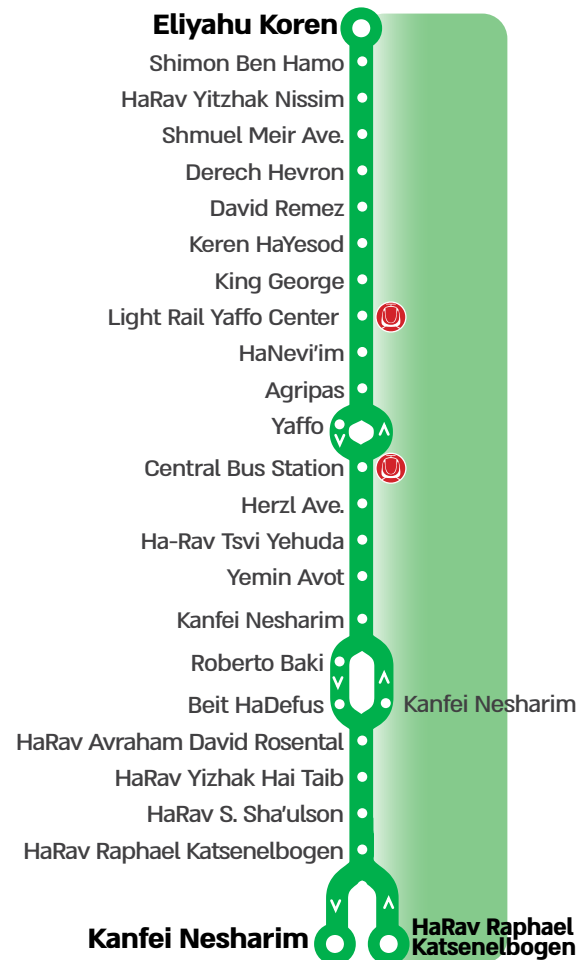

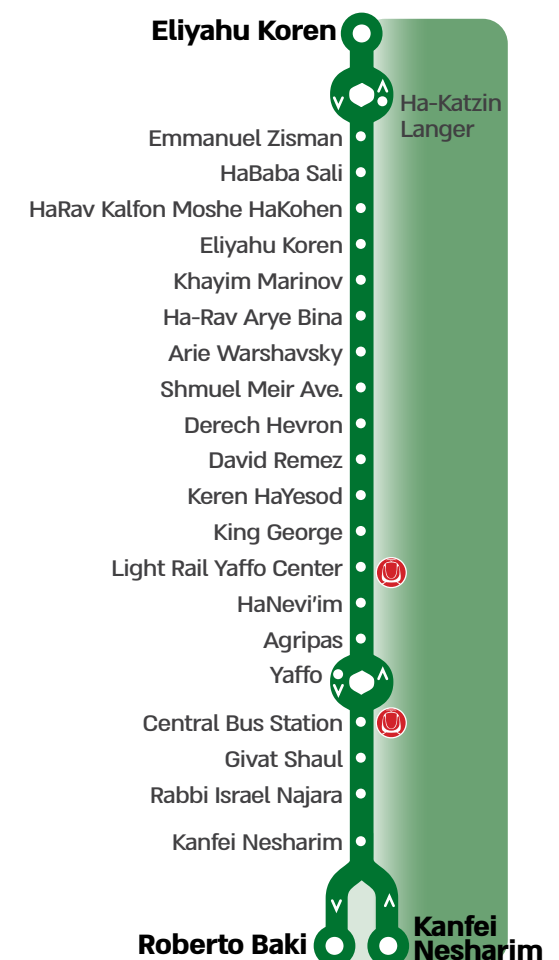

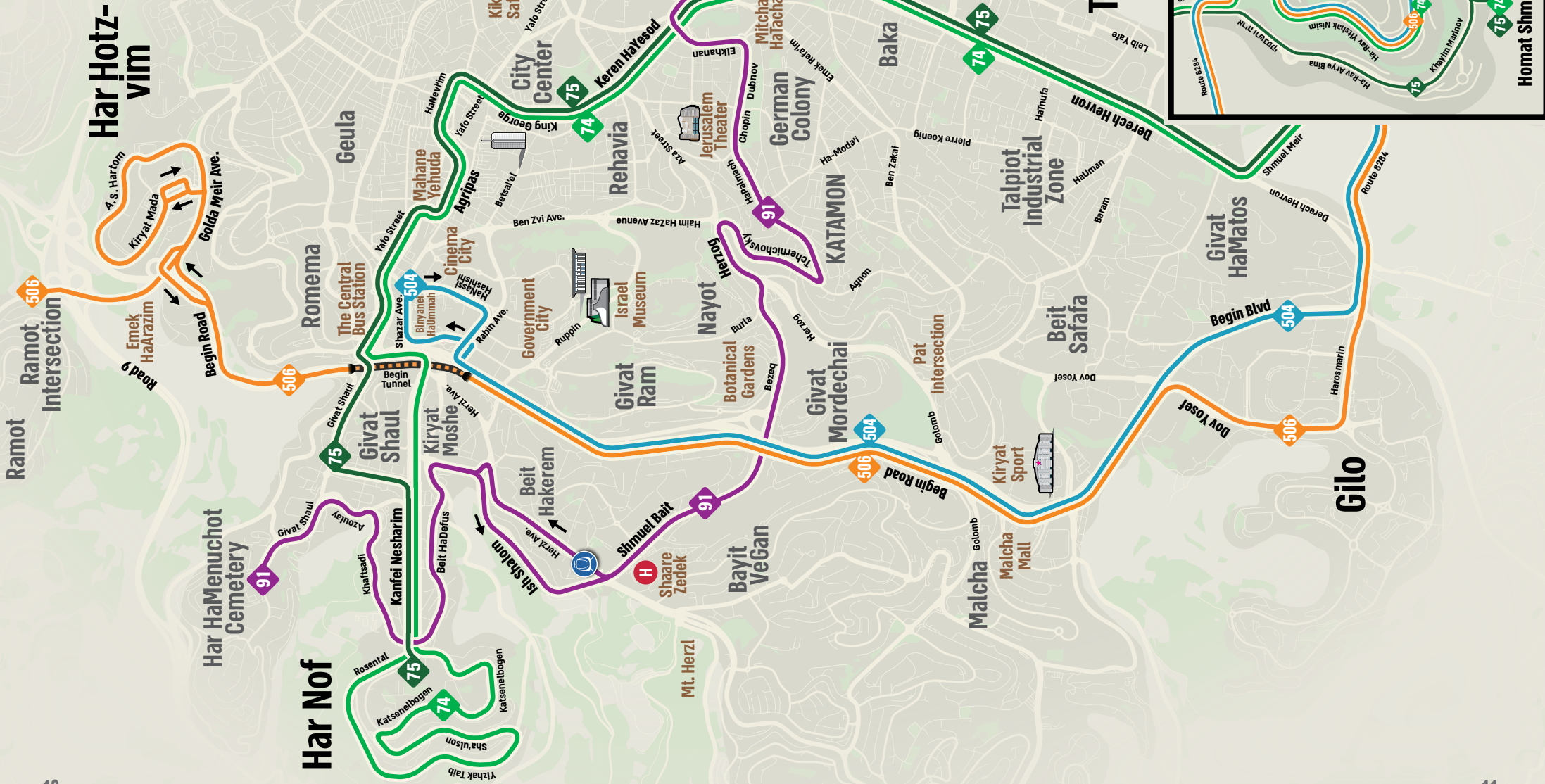
