



Jerusalem Deserves *A wholehearted service*

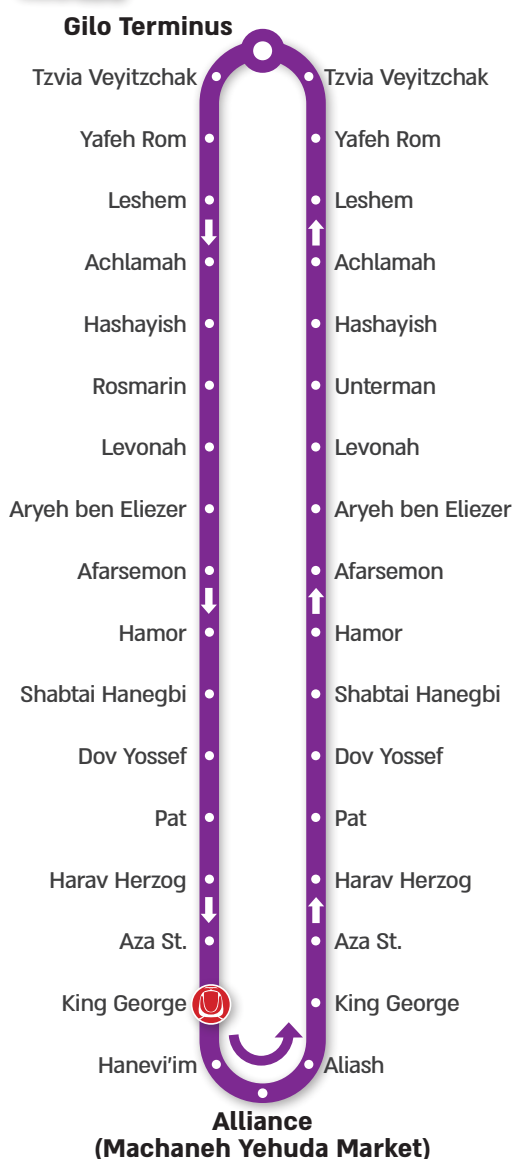
The Ministry of Transport and the National Public Transport Authority are proud to announce: **Changes and improvements in the bus lines**

as of June 10, 2022; 11th of Sivan, 5782

As part of the development of the public transport in Jerusalem, the Superbus Company will operate two new lines, numbers **62** and **92**, which will replace the cancelled Line Number **32** (Gilo – Ramot), **with shorter, more reliable routes and with an improved frequency**. Furthermore, Line **31** will be operated by Superbus with no change in route and with an improved time schedule.

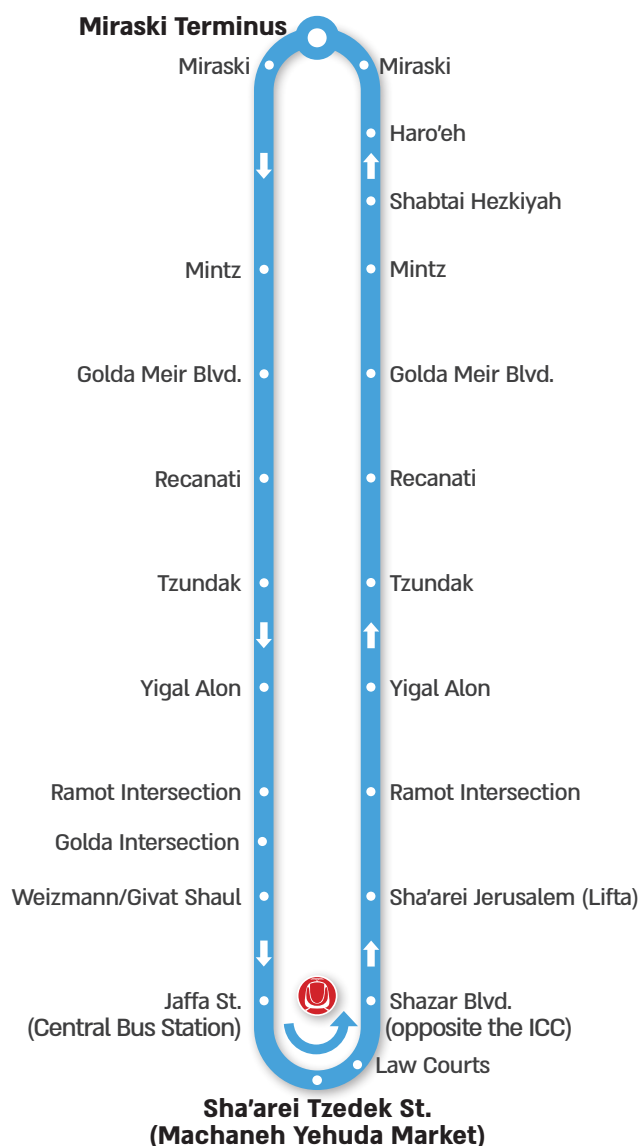

Gilo – Ramot (Via Begin Road)

The line will be operated by Superbus with no change in route and with an improved time schedule.

The alternative morning line from Gilo to Givat Ram and the alternative afternoon line from Givat Ram to Gilo will be cancelled. Line **92** will serve passengers from Gilo to Herzog Boulevard (Pat Intersection) from which Lines 9 and 42 could serve passengers to Givat Ram.

The alternative morning line from Ramot to the Government Campus will continue to operate under the new Line **62**. Take note of changes in the time schedule.

Lines **504** and **531** will henceforth travel along a circular route from the suburbs to the Israel Conference Center and back.
